## PORTA NUOVA: THE NEW SKYLINE OF MILAN

Porta Nuova is one of the symbols of the city. It served as the world's flagship for Expo 2015 and is one of the city's liveliest and coolest areas due to the beauty of its award-winning skyscrapers.

The **new skyline of the Porta Nuova** area is now one of the symbols of the city of Milan, not only for the beauty of its buildings but also because it has always had a green soul devoted to environmental sustainability. A complex area, still evolving, which today is a conglomerate of new, award-winning buildings of dizzying heights, of which architect Stefano Boeri's **Bosco Verticale** is the most iconic image.



Around the large park known as **Biblioteca degli Alberi** Milano, some of the city's tallest buildings stand out,

such as the **Palazzo delle Regione Lombardia**, the **Unicredit Tower** by César Pelli, the new **Coima Headquarters**, the **Torre Diamante**, the **Solaria** and **Aria residential towers**.

These have been joined by other construction sites: from the 'Vertical Nest' to the 'Splinter', from the 'Galfa Tower' to the future project of the 'Botanical Tower' that takes the experience of the Vertical Forest and mixes it with the High-Line in the Big Apple.

The tour ends with a **stroll along Corso Como**, famous for its nightlife, and **Piazza Venticinque Aprile** where, it is possible to make a brief stop at Eataly, a temple of Italian taste and gastronomy.
