The Duomo, dedicated to Maria Nascente, is more than a church, it is the symbol and pride of the Milanese.

And its terraces, from which you can admire the **city's renewed skyline from 360 degrees**, are splendid, breathtaking. You will approach the sky, observing the dense embroidery of rampant arches, pinnacles spires and statues that offer an astonishing spectacle. You will see the famous '**Madonnina**' from close up, which is still unsurpassed in height - so the city's master plan dictates!
