### LEONARDO, TITIAN, CARAVAGGIO AND RAFFAELLO: THE BEAUTY OF THE AMBROSIAN PICTURE GALLERY

The '*Atlantic Codex sheets*' and the '*Portrait of a Musician*' by Leonardo da Vinci, the '*Adoration of the Magi*' by Titian, the '*Basket of Fruit*' by Caravaggio, the '*Cartoon of the School of Athens*' that Raphael made in preparation for the fresco in the Vatican rooms: these are just some of the great masterpieces that you can admire in the special rooms of the **Pinacoteca Ambrosiana**, one of the most visited galleries in Milan and the first museum to be opened to the public in Italy.

Let's enjoy the incredible collections housed in the **Palazzo dell'Ambrosiana** where the noble Cardinal Federico Borromeo had his Library set up in 1600, a rich collection of precious books and manuscripts to which he added, in 1618, the private collection of 250 paintings, the first nucleus of the future Pinacoteca Ambrosiana.
