

A LITTLE VERSAILLES ON THE OUTSKIRTS OF MILAN: THE VILLA REALE OF MONZA

There is a small Versailles on the outskirts of Milan commissioned by Empress Maria Theresa of Austria.

In Monza, not far from the famous autodrome, an incredible experience awaits you.

Behind closed doors, you will have the chance to visit this Neoclassical jewel with a tour that will take you from the Habsburgs to the Savoy dynasty. A visit through twenty-eight rooms between flats and halls, for a **walk-through beauty and history**.

The visit starts in the entrance hall with the scenic ballroom and then continues through the state rooms on the first noble



floor and into the rooms on the second floor: here you will see the famous and rich flats of the **Prince of Naples**, the **Duchess of Genoa**, the **Emperor of Germany** and then the **King and Queen's rooms**.



How to reach: Taking the train from Garibaldi Porta Nuova Station in less than half an hour you can visit Monza and the Villa Reale.
